

Welcome to the Birthing Center at Columbus Regional Hospital

The following information will help you find your way to the Birthing Center when you come to the hospital.

WHERE DO I GO?

If you are 20 weeks or more along in your pregnancy, please enter the hospital through the Courtyard Entrance. If you need assistance, you can use the phone located to the left inside the first set of doors in the Courtyard Entrance. If you do not require assistance, you may take the elevators across from the Courtyard Entrance and go to the right, walk a short distance to the Birthing Center which will be the last hallway on the left. Please use the phone near the doors to notify the nursing staff that you have arrived.

WHAT DO I DO IF IT IS NIGHT?

If you arrive between 8:30 pm and 7:00 am, all entrances to the hospital are locked with the exception of the Emergency Department Entrance. Please use the Emergency Entrance during the overnight hours. Someone will be available to escort you to the birthing center.

WHERE SHOULD WE PARK?

The person driving can park temporarily at the Courtyard Entrance and then find a spot in the visitors parking after you have been assisted.

WHERE DO I GO IF IT IS AN EMERGENCY?

If you have a need for emergency care and are less than 20 weeks along in your pregnancy, please use the Emergency Department at Columbus Regional Hospital which can be accessed from 17th Street.

BIRTHING CENTER VISITING HOURS:

Visiting hours are from 10:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. unless you are laboring. No children under 14 unless they are siblings of the baby.
