WARNING SIGNS IN PREGNANCY

You, the patient, are the most important person during this pregnancy along with the bundle of joy you are carrying.

Please watch out for these warning signs:

- Vaginal Bleeding (like a period)
- Spotting that continues for more than 24 hours
- Change in vaginal discharge (itching, burning, or odor)
- Burning or pain with urination
- Fluid leaking from vagina continuously
- Persistent vomiting for more than 24 hours
- Preterm labor (5 or more contractions in 1 hour, if less than 36 weeks)
- Severe, continuous headaches with blurry vision
- Herpes outbreak or any exposure to STD's
- Decreased or NO fetal movement.
